

Graduation Requirements

Please check that your grade 12 advisees have the course requirements to graduate.

The Requirements for a High School Diploma:

To earn an Alberta High School Diploma a student must meet the following requirements:

- ❑ **Earn a minimum of 100 credits**

- ❑ **Complete and meet the standards of the following courses:**
 - English 30-1 or English 30-2;
 - Social Studies 30 or 33;
 - One of: Pure Mathematics 20, Applied Math 20, or Mathematics 24;
 - One of: Science 20, Science 24, Biology 20, Chemistry 20, or Physics 20.

- ❑ **Complete and meet the standards of the following:**
 - Physical Education 10 (3 credits);
 - Career and Life Management (CALM) 20 (3 credits);
 - 10 credits for Career and Technology Studies or fine arts or physical education (beyond PE 10) or second languages;
 - In addition to English 30-1 or 30-2 and Social Studies 30 or 33, students pursuing a high school diploma must earn 10 credits in any other 30 level courses.
